## **Terms and Conditions for Junior Basketball Competition Registration**

#### 1. General

- 1.1. These Terms and Conditions govern the registration and participation in the Junior Basketball Competition organised by Northern Districts Basketball Association (NDBA).
- 1.2. By registering for the competition, participants and their guardians agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.
- 1.3. NDBA reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions at any time. Participants will be notified of any changes.

## 2. Eligibility

- 2.1. The competition is open to junior players within the age groups specified by NDBA.
- 2.2. Proof of age may be required at the time of registration.
- 2.3. All participants must have parental or legal guardian consent to register.

## 3. Registration and Fees

- 3.1. Registration must be completed through the official NDBA registration platform before the stated deadline.
- 3.2. Registration fees must be paid in full before participation is confirmed.
- 3.3. Fees are non-refundable except in circumstances outlined in Section 6 (Cancellations and Refunds).

#### 4. Code of Conduct

- 4.1. All participants, coaches, and spectators must adhere to NDBA's Code of Conduct.
- 4.2. Unsportsmanlike behaviour, including but not limited to verbal or physical abuse, discrimination, or misconduct, may result in suspension or expulsion from the competition.

## 5. Insurance and Liability

- 5.1. While NDBA takes reasonable steps to ensure participant safety, players participate at their own risk.
- 5.2. NDBA is not liable for any injuries, accidents, or personal property loss incurred during the competition.

### 6. Cancellations and Refunds

- 6.1. In the event of competition cancellation by NDBA, a refund or credit towards future competitions will be offered.
- 6.2. Players who have not participated in any games during the competition season are eligible for a full refund, minus the GameDay administration fee up until the first week of competition. Refund requests will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis, with the final refund amount determined by expenses incurred up to the request date.
- 6.3. If a participant is removed from the competition due to a breach of the Code of Conduct, no refund will be provided.

#### 7. Media and Photography

- 7.1. By registering, participants and their guardians grant NDBA permission to capture and use photographs or videos for promotional purposes.
- 7.2. Any requests to opt out of media use must be submitted in writing to NDBA.

# 8. Privacy Policy

- 8.1. Personal information collected during registration will be used solely for competition administration and communication.
- 8.2. NDBA will not share personal data with third parties without consent, except as required by law.

# 9. Dispute Resolution

- 9.1. Any disputes regarding competition matters must be submitted in writing to NDBA for review.
- 9.2. NDBA's decision on disputes shall be final.
